Pastor's Weekly Message

FR. JEREMY THOMAS

We often use the expression “Back in the day..” to refer to a time in the past when things were different and possibly better. We might call it a golden era.

Our patron, St Gregory of Nyssa, was part of what is thought of as a golden era in the life of the Church. The work of the apostles was still fresh in the minds of believers and there was a lot excitement as people asked questions about what faith in Jesus really meant. So, back in the day, St Gregory of Nyssa spoke and taught very eloquently about the importance of Baptism. Bear in mind that at that time, only adults were baptized. In a famous sermon St Gregory made the following point.

“Show me, after sacramental grace, the change in your ways that should follow it, ...there is need of some manifest proof, by which we may recognize the new-born man, discerning by clear tokens the new from the old.”

Most of us were baptized as infants, so we do not look for visible differences in how Baptism has changed the life of a baby. However, every Easter, the grace of our Baptism for all of us is renewed.

A very good exercise during the 50 days of Easter is to ask ourselves, in the same way St Gregory asks: What proof is there in my life that I have let go of old ways and taken on new ways as a result of my Baptism?

Faith in the Risen Lord, really does make a difference to our life. Our patron saint is asking us: “How?”

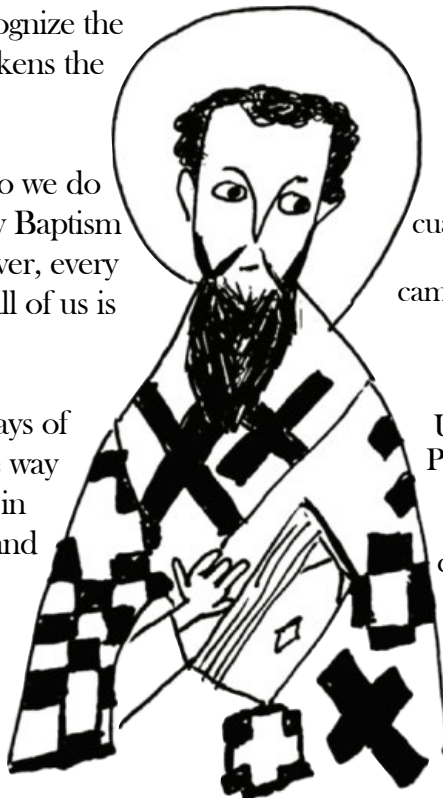
En aquel entonces, San Gregorio de Nisa habló y enseñó muy elocuentemente sobre la importancia del Bautismo. Tengamos en cuenta que en aquella época sólo se bautizaban adultos. En un famoso sermón, San Gregorio señaló lo siguiente.

“Muéstrame, después de la gracia sacramental, el cambio en tu forma de ser que debe seguirse... es necesario que se manifieste alguna prueba, mediante la cual podamos reconocer al hombre recién nacido, discerniendo con señales claras lo nuevo de lo viejo”.

La mayoría de nosotros fuimos bautizados cuando éramos bebés, por lo que no buscamos diferencias visibles en cómo el bautismo ha cambiado la vida de un bebé. Sin embargo, cada Pascua se renueva la gracia de nuestro Bautismo para todos nosotros.

Un muy buen ejercicio durante los 50 días de Pascua es preguntarnos, del mismo modo que pregunta San Gregorio: ¿Qué prueba hay en mi vida de que he dejado atrás los viejos caminos y he asumido nuevos caminos como resultado de mi Bautismo?

La fe en el Señor Resucitado realmente hace una diferencia en nuestra vida. Nuestro santo patrón nos pregunta: “¿De que manera?”



We are so very grateful for your support through this collection as we work together to nourish and nurture mothers in need.

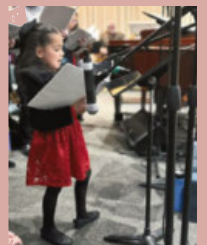
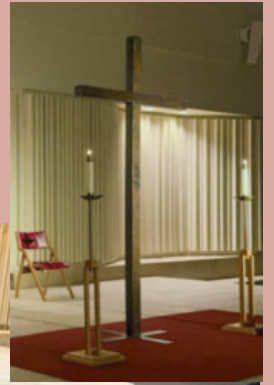
