It should be no surprise to any of us that we have felt hurt or frustrated or confused during this first year of unification. And yet, at times we are surprised.



I've noticed people comment from both campuses about "over there" and what they do or don't do or say or don't say. We are surprised and at times affronted by the differences that exist.


En el centro de ser parte de la Iglesia está la relación. Jesús nos llama por nombre a ser Su Iglesia y a ser Uno en Él.


Se buscan ideas para recaudar fondos


Dependiendo de cuántos voluntarios tenemos, su compromiso sería unavez cada 4 a 6 semanas.
