Instructions for the Confirmation Mass

Greetings! Your child's Confirmation is fast approaching!

We join with you in prayer for your candidate who guided by the Holy Spirit, will receive the gifts of wisdom, knowledge, understanding, right judgment, courage, piety, reverence, awe and wonder in God's presence. In order for your child's Confirmation Day to flow smoothly, we have important information for you:

- **REHEARSAL**: The candidates and sponsors are to attend the <u>rehearsal on Tuesday, May 14th at 6:00pm</u>. If the sponsor cannot attend the rehearsal, we ask that a parent attend in his/her place.
- **CHECK IN:** On Confirmation day, we ask that the **candidate and sponsor arrive at 4:45 pm**. The candidates will take a group picture and meet with the Bishop before the Mass. The group picture will be outside, on the front steps, weather permitting, so please arrive early.
- **SEATING:** Seating is limited. You will have a <u>total of 4 seats maximum:</u> the candidate, 1 sponsor and parents. 6 seats total for 2 candidates, if they are siblings. Seating for the candidate and sponsor is assigned. The Sponsor will sit next to the candidate. Parents can sit on either sides of the church. We will be streaming the Confirmation for other family members who will not be able to attend.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** There will be NO PHOTOGRAPHY or VIDEO RECORDING permitted in the sanctuary area (around the altar) or aisles. **Please do not hire professional photographers**; they will not be allowed into the church. You may only take pictures from your seats. Photos with the Bishop and Fr. Jeremy will be available after the Mass.
- **SPRINKLING RITE:** There will be a Sprinkling Rite during Mass for the blessing of sacramental gifts. We ask that parents keep these items during the ceremony. The candidates should not have anything in their hands to avoid distractions. It is not required to bring a candle. Any other religious items are optional.
- **RECONCILIATION:** Students are expected to go to confession once before or during Advent and once before or during Lent.
- **COMMUNION:** The candidate and the sponsor will receive Holy Communion together. All other guests may receive Communion thereafter.

• DRESS CODE:

Keep in mind that this is a church event and should not be compared to the dress style that would be appropriate for a graduation or a prom. Please use good judgment in selecting your attire. If in doubt, do not wear it.

While the church greatly respects the uniqueness and individuality in each of its members, it holds that modesty is a fruit of the Holy Spirit and "Teaching modesty to children and adolescents means awakening in them respect for the human person." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 2521-2524).

DRESS CODE

It is in this spirit of fostering respect for each other and for sanctity of the Sacrament of Confirmation that we set forth a code of dress consistent with our Catholic culture's view of modesty. Please share this information with your sponsor.

LADIES' DRESS CODE:

Ladies are to wear either a blouse and skirt of conservative length, or a dress of the same fashion. The dress should be <u>delicate</u>, <u>simple and modest</u> (no miniskirts, dresses above the knee or tight clothing). Color is choice of the candidate.

Shoulders are to be covered.

No spaghetti straps or sleeveless blouses or dresses. No low cut dresses. Necklines should be conservative. No open back dresses or tops; no bare midriffs. Sheer or see through wraps are not an acceptable cover-up for sleeveless or spaghetti strap blouses and dresses or miniskirts. Girls with sleeveless dresses must wear a jacket, shawl or sweater.

MEN'S DRESS CODE:

Men are to wear a tucked in dress shirt of any color (but preferably white), dress pants (of the proper waist size and inseam length) and jackets are preferred but optional. A belt and dress socks should also be worn.

SHOE CODE:

Not to be worn: Sneakers, hiking shoes, flip flops. Shoes should be of a dressy nature. Ladies' shoes should be of a conservative heel height. No stiletto-type high heels. Open-toe dress shoes for ladies are acceptable, but flip flops are not.

MEN'S DRESS CODE

- Attire should be formal.
- Suit
- Dress shirt tucked-in.
- Tie
- Jacket is preferred but optional
- Dress pants of proper size.
- No jeans.
- Belt
- Dress shoes (no sneakers).
- Dress socks.



LADIES' DRESS CODE

- Dress should be delicate, simple and modest.
- Shoulders are covered.
- Higher neckline.
- No open back dresses or tops.
- No bare midriffs.
- Wear a shawl or sweater, if needed.
- Blouse and knee length skirt or dress.
- No miniskirts, dresses above the knee or tight clothing.
- Color is choice of the candidate.
- Dress shoes of a conservative heel height.
- No: stilettos, flip-flops or sneakers.
